

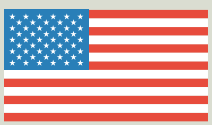


# RECONSTRUCTION

Thirteenth Amendment- Abolished slavery



Fourteenth Amendment- Granted African Americans citizenship



Fifteenth Amendment- Granted African Americans suffrage

## PLANS FOR RECONSTRUCTION



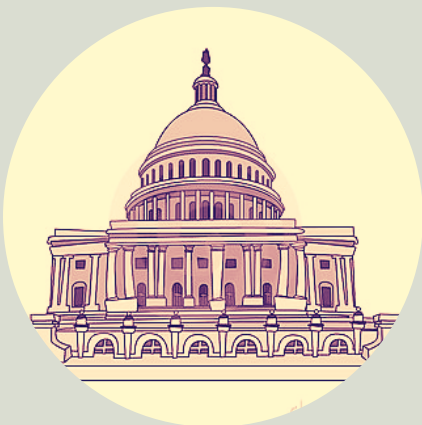
LINCOLN'S PLAN

- Ten Percent Plan
- Wanted to reunite the country quickly
- Pardoned Confederates, except high ranking officials
- After 10% of people took an oath of allegiance they could be readmitted and gain seats in Congress



JOHNSON'S PLAN

- Presidential Reconstruction
- All remaining Confederate states can be readmitted if:
  - Withdraw secession
  - Swear allegiance to Union
  - Annul war debts
  - Ratify 13th amendment
- Did not address what will happen to former slaves



CONGRESS'S PLAN

- Congressional Reconstruction
- Refused to admit any newly elected Southern legislators
- Pushed for Freedmen's Bureau
- Passed Civil Rights Act
- Forbade black codes
